Championships for this year are down to Singles for both Men and Women. Surprisingly, the entries for both Men's and Women's Singles are the best for some time.

The issues with the Pairs not finishing and finishing late have been sent to State Match Committee. I have been informed that the program and the length of Pairs games is being looked at for next year.

There are 29 teams in Women's Pennants and 50 in Men's Pennants this year.

The Women's Pennants is active in Bowlslink, and the Men's Pennants should be done by the end of this week. We will keep a local point score, but be aware that the ladder in Bowlslink is the official one.

Hopefully, we will be having a basic Bowlslink training session next week, to be run by Andrew Lyn, showing how to access and input teams each week, and also, how to put results into the system.

Note: Everyone can View draws and results in Bowlslink, you do not need to have special access for that.

Now that the draws have been released for Women's Pennants – Any player transferring to a new Club can only play in their current Division Grade. Clubs can appeal to SMC, if they have an issue with that.

The State Finals for Championships is on the BNSW website and the program for Nationals is available on the Bowls Australia Website.

A couple of the Clubs are affected by the nationals with their Pennant games, and they have 2 Options. Play without those players OR, move games by mutual agreement with opponents. If there are any problems doing that, the Match Committee will have to sort it out.

Division 2 Men's Pennants requires 2 double headers to fit in, but there are options to move Round 8. Please see the draw that has been sent out.

The Match Committee is struggling to attend as many games as we would like, so where possible, we have to play Semi Finals and Finals on the same day. Depending on what comes from SMC regarding next years program, we may be able to change things.

We are waiting for score cards, so up to Semi Finals, we are asking Clubs to fill out cards for us.



Next Season, the expectation from Bowls NSW is that Championships will be on Bowlslink. We may have to get additional people trained on "How to set up Competitions", as it is very time consuming.
